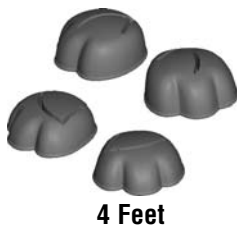
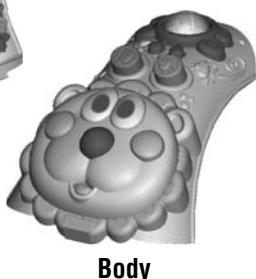
Requires three "AA" batteries (included) for operation.

Adult assembly is required. Tool required for assembly: Phillips screwdriver (not included).

Wipe this toy with a clean, damp cloth. Do not immerse.

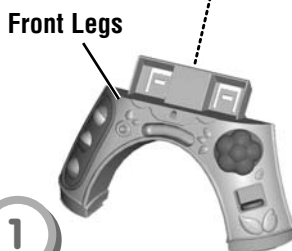
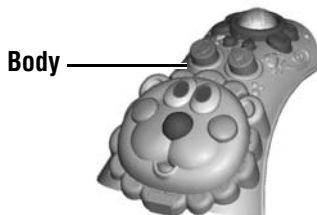
#8 x 3/4" Screw - 5

Tighten all screws with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

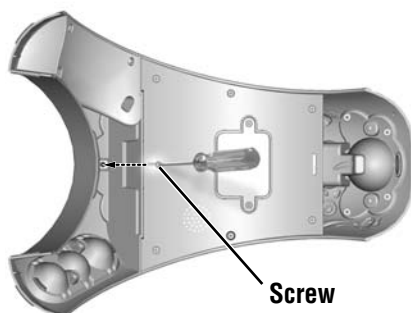
Assembly

CAUTION

This product contains small parts in its unassembled state. Adult assembly is required.



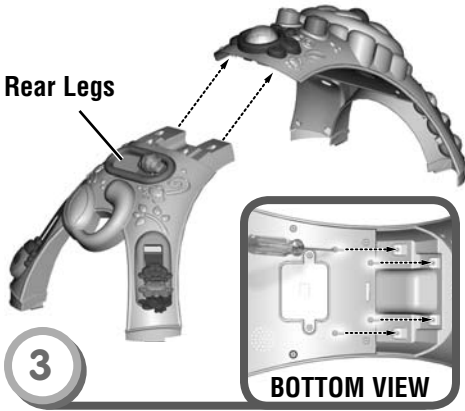
- Fit the tab on the front legs into the opening under the head on the body. Push the front legs into the opening.
Hint: This may require some force.



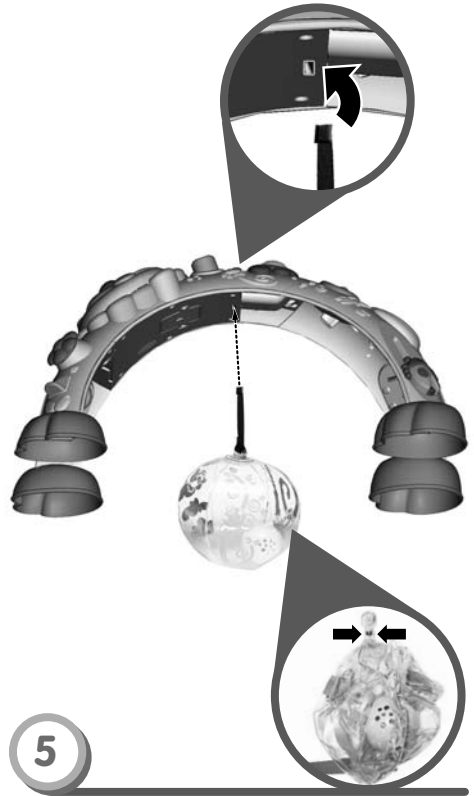
2 BOTTOM VIEW

- Turn the assembly over.
Hint: Be sure to place the assembly on a protective surface to prevent scratching.
- Insert a screw into the hole near the front legs and tighten.

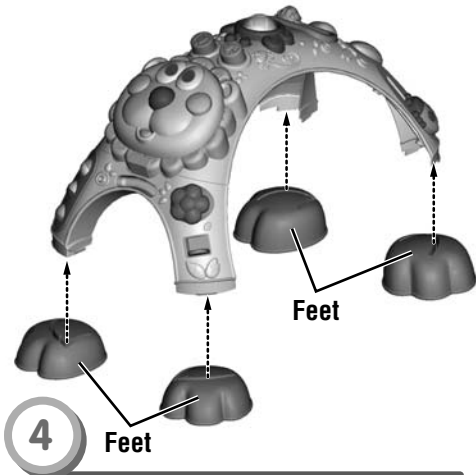
Assembly



- Fit the rear legs into the body, as shown.
- Insert the four screws into the holes near the rear legs and tighten.



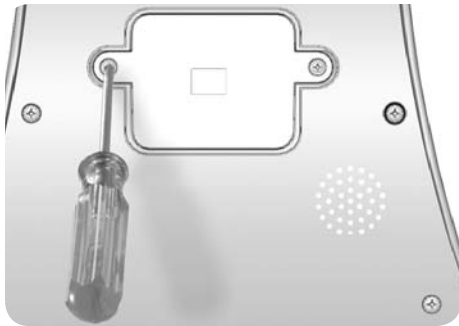
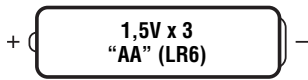
- Squeeze the stem on the ball to inflate it.
- Fit the T-end of the ball strap up through the slot under the assembly.



- Fit the feet onto the end of each leg. Push to “snap” each foot in place.

Hint: Each foot is designed to fit one way. If it does not seem to fit, turn it around and try again.

Battery Replacement



For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries in this toy with three, new “AA” (LR6) alkaline batteries.

- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the toy.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and throw them away.
- Insert three, new “AA” (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.

Hint: We recommend using *alkaline* batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws.
- If this product begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/volume switch off and then back on.
- When sounds or lights become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.



- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities (Europe only).

Battery Safety Information




In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Power/Volume Switch

- Slide the power/volume switch to ON with low volume  or ON with high volume 
- Spin the roller ball or press the lion's nose to watch the lights, and listen to fun songs and silly sounds!
- Spin the roller balls, slide the ladybug or press the pop-up pegs for even more fun!
- When you are finished playing with this toy, slide the power/volume switch OFF .
